The purpose of an A.S.A.P program is to encourage a proactive relationship between SWA, AMFA, and the FAA. This proactive agreement will be used to encourage voluntary self-disclosure of safety concerns, by both contract and non-contract employees with out having company disciplinary or FAA legal action taken against them if they meet the guidelines of the A.S.A.P MOU. The information collected will be used to increase education and awareness levels of flight safety.
